

e-confirm began at 8:30 a.m. on August 1st. and ends at 11:59 p.m. on August 17th

The e-confirm process is new and improved. It should be much easier to complete enrollment confirmation through e-confirm.

You can access enrollment confirmation through C-N Connect, like always, or through the C-N mobile app, available for download in the app store on your mobile device.

BEFORE YOU CAN E-CONFIRM:

- 1. Clear any holds prior to beginning the enrollment confirmation process in C-N Connect.
- 2. Make any changes to class schedule.
- 3. Pay account balance or set up a payment plan at www.tuitionassistant.com.
 You can pay online by using C-N Connect, or by credit card by calling 865-471-3209.
- 4. Log into C-N Connect or the C-N mobile app and follow the e-confirm process.

If you are unable to e-confirm, then you must confirm in person in the Fite Administration Building in the Student One Stop office.

Students who confirm enrollment for the Fall 2022 semester after Tuesday, August 16th will be charged late enrollment and registration fees of \$25.00. Failure to confirm registration by 11:59 p.m. on Tuesday, August 16th may result in cancelation of aid and drop of class schedule.

If you have not already completed your Financial Aid Checklist, do so in your MyCN account.

Students who have a credit balance and want to use a book voucher to purchase books must sign and return the Authorization Form. Forms are available online at the following link:
