Continuous Assessment Plan

Key Learning Objectives Assessment (KLOA) System of Counselor Competencies

- Learning objectives are assessed in each course each semester to determine level of student mastery.
- KLOA data are reviewed by faculty to assess student mastery and KLOA system reliability.
- KLOA annual results are reviewed with each student by faculty advisor.

Professional Development Assessments

- Advisor-Advisee conferences held annually to review the Professional Development Performance and Dispositions of each student.
- Faculty examines the Dispositions Rubric and Professional Development Plan of each student at three stages during training.
