

Graduate Programs Transfer Credit Consideration

Complete this form only if you are requesting to transfer credit from graduate coursework into this program.

This form must be returned in order for your transcripts to be evaluated.

The following steps provide applicants the opportunity to receive an UNOFFICIAL transcript review from the Office of Adult and Graduate Studies. This UNOFFICIAL review can be used to determine transfer credits you may receive for coursework completed at another university or college.

NOTICE: This process is only available for applicants who provide readable copies of transcripts. Transfer credits must be unencumbered having not been counted towards a previous degree, and must take the place of a course in the cohort sequence, as determined by the Education Department. Carson-Newman accepts up to nine (9) semester hours of graduate credit from a regionally accredited college or university towards completing the MAT, MEd, and EdS degrees and up to twelve (12) credits towards the EdD degree. Awarding of transfer credits occurs after OFFICIAL, sealed transcripts containing the transfer credits for consideration are received, and you are fully admitted to the university.
