Note: The last date to drop a course **without being charged for the course** is the last business day before the module begins. Module classes are part of an academic term. Students who confirm enrollment or begin attendance in any course will incur charges. To not incur charges, courses should be dropped by the date and time indicated on the Timetable of Dates, which is the last business day before the module begins. The academic terms are fall, spring and summer. Dropping module courses during any term may result in aid recalculation or return of funds for that term. When a student drops all courses or discontinues attendance, the student is a withdrawal and follows the withdrawal policy for refunds and financial aid re-calculations. Financial Aid recipients withdrawing or discontinuing enrollment may not earn all financial aid which may result in a charges due to the University.
