

YELLOW RIBBON PROGRAM

The Yellow Ribbon Program is a provision of the Post 9/11 Veterans Educational Assistance Act of 2008.

Under the Yellow Ribbon agreement, the remaining amount of tuition and fees will be matched by Carson-Newman University and the Department of Veterans Affairs. This means 100% of your tuition and eligible fees (*does not include room and board*) will be paid while enrolled at Carson-Newman.

The Department of Veterans Affairs will also pay you a monthly housing allowance, which can be used toward a payment plan for on campus room and board charges, and up to \$1,000 stipend for books and supplies.

How do I apply for Yellow Ribbon?

Students who plan to use their VA Educational Benefits must notify the Director of Veteran Services and complete the Request for Benefits form. Once the student receives a copy of their Certificate of Eligibility (COE), they must forward a copy to the Director of Veteran Services. The COE will tell if the student is eligible for Yellow Ribbon.

How will I know if I am accepted into the Yellow Program?

The Yellow Ribbon Portion will be posted on the student's account as a statement credit for the semester in which the student is eligible. Pell Grants, federal student loans and the Hope scholarship are funds designated for total cost of attendance and will not be included in computing the net cost for tuition and fees.



Carson-Newman will make an offer of financial assistance based on institutional awarding policies, and will not reduce the amount of merit scholarships due to eligibility for Yellow Ribbon Payments but reserves the right to reduce other institutional aid under the University Reduction of Aid Policy.

Carson-Newman will apply financial assistance for which the student is eligible and/or outside scholarships received designated for tuition and fees toward the student's charges for tuition and fees for the semester.

The amount that is remaining for tuition and fees (net cost) will be the portion that will be paid from the VA (**up to \$26,042.81 per year in tuition and fees**). Yellow Ribbon payments will be distributed by the term (*semester*) in which the student qualifies.

If the student enrolls in the summer sessions, the Yellow Ribbon program amount will be applied based on each term of the enrollment and by the remaining eligibility of funds.
