

A Short List of Scholarships and Grants

Below is a list of scholarships and grants I have found through basic searching. This is NOT an exhaustive list. I encourage you to search for scholarships that relate to you. I recommend googling “study abroad scholarship for” then inserting a description relevant to you (e.g., women of color; XXX Honors Society; Eagle Scout, etc.). If you find any that look really good, please forward the information to me (swelsh@cn.edu) so I can add them to my list.

Here are some tips:

1. I suggest that to get organized by checking the criteria and deadlines for the various options below and any you find.
2. Then apply to as many as you can. This can be a time-consuming process, but it could be well worth the effort.
 - a. Essays and/or letters of recommendation are required for many of these applications; so, give yourself plenty of time to get everything done.
3. If you need help navigating the details, make an appointment with Melissa Summey (msummey@cn.edu). She can help you with the application and such.

 - For: undergraduate or graduate students of limited financial means who have received the Federal Pell Grant
 - Deadline: October 6th, 2022 (STRICT)
 - Applications open in mid-August
- [Gilman-DAAD Germany Scholarship](#): up to \$5,000
 - For: undergraduate or graduate students of limited financial means who have received the Federal Pell Grant and are studying abroad in Germany
 - Deadline: October 4th, 2022 (STRICT)
 - Applications open in mid-August
- [Gilman for France Scholarship](#): up to \$5,000
 - For: undergraduate or graduate students of limited financial means who have received the Federal Pell Grant and are studying abroad in France
 - Deadline: October 6th, 2022 (STRICT)
 - Applications open in mid-August
- [TEAN Study Abroad Scholarships](#): \$1,000-\$5,000
 - Merit-based, Need-based, and Diversity Scholarships available
 - Diversity includes, but is not limited to, students identifying as underrepresented races, ethnic origins, sexual orientations, gender identities, as well as first generation college students and those with accessibility needs.

- [Gilman-McCain Scholarship](#): up to \$5,000
 - For: child dependents of active-duty service members
 - Deadline: October 6th, 2022 (STRICT)
 - Applications open in mid-August

Silver or Gold Award Girl Scout

 - For: Silver or Gold Award Girl Scout undergraduate with a minimum of 3.0 GPA
 - Deadline: May 12th, 2023
 - Application must be mailed

- [Diversity Network Summer Scholarship](#): \$500 (suspended due to COVID)
 - For: undergraduate students experiencing diversity, which includes being a first generation college student, being an ethnic minority, identifying as LGBTQ+, coming from a low-income household, and/or having a disability.
- [Diverse International Women of Color Summer 2022 Study Abroad Scholarship](#): \$500
 - May or may not be available for Summer 2023
