Procedure to receive credit:

Official score reports must be submitted to the Office of the Registrar. Upon receipt of exam scores, the student will receive a letter from the Registrar indicating whether credit can be granted based on the score obtained. If the student achieved the required score, the student is notified by letter regarding the procedure to obtain course credit. The student must pay \$10.00 per credit hour in the C-N Student Accounts Office and then bring the receipt to the Office of the Registrar. Once payment has been made and the receipt is received, the credit is posted to the student's transcript. Grades for all credit by exam is awarded as S grades.
